**REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD  
OF THE ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES SUPERVISOR BADGE**

1. *Eligibility*

The Adventure Activities Supervisor (AAS) Badge shall be authorized for wear by:

- (a) Members of the Special Activities Flight (SAF) who have successfully completed the Adventure Activities Supervisor Course; and
- (b) Members of SAF who hold qualifications deemed equivalent to the Adventure Activities Supervisor Qualification by the Chief Adventure Activities Supervisor.

Former members of SAF who have satisfactorily served the unit for at least two years after qualification and achieved a minimum of 80% attendance shall also be permitted to wear the badge permanently.

2. *Description*

The Badge is a cloth insignia featuring the legendary Sword of Damocles, embroidered in red, superimposing a reversed dark blue elongated triangle. The Badge shall be worn by qualified members on the left upper sleeve of No 1 Service Dress, one centimetre below the Air Force Eagle insignia by Sergeant Instructors and Instructors, and two centimetres below the HKACC Shoulder Title by all other members.

It is worn at a relative position on the No 2A Routine Working Dress, and optionally on the No 2B Routine Working Dress. A subdued version in grey/black is worn on the No 3B Field Dress.

3. *Recommending Authority*

Recommendations for the award of the Adventure Activities Supervisor Badge shall be submitted by the Chief Adventure Activities Supervisor, through the Chief Staff Officer, to the Commanding Officer. The Badge shall be awarded on the authority of the Commanding Officer and a notification of such award shall be duly published.
