(B) Application Guidelines:

- 1. No courses fee with be charged, however, all successful applicants are required to arrange and be responsible for their own air tickets, meals, transport and accommodations. Full or partial subsidy of travel expenses to and from London and RAF Cranwell, accommodations and daily meals during the stay in RAF Cranwell may be provided subject to availability of funding allocated by the Corps.
- 2. Consideration of applications will commence on 7 June 2019 until the vacancies are filled. Interested members are highly encouraged to submit their applications as soon as possible.
- 3. The selection committee chaired by CO thanks applicants for their interest, but advises that only candidates shortlisted will be notified of the application result. The confirmation of acceptance will be officially issued by ATF, ATC. The pre-departure briefing session organized by VQU is mandatory for all ATF candidates.
- 4. After graduation, the ATF graduates will be invited to contribute to the training activities by ATWg.
