Associate of Science in Aviation and Pilot Studies (AScAvPS) – Last call for applicants!

YOUR ROUTE TO FLY HIGH! Together with our Corps, the Community College of City University (CCCU) / the University of Wollongong College Hong Kong (UOWCHK) has been launching the two-year **Associate of Science in Aviation and Pilot Studies** (理學副學士(航空及飛行)) since September 2018.

With the growing demand in piloting professionals, the programme aims to provide the basic theory, technical knowledge and practical skills required for understanding aircraft technology and piloting an aircraft. There is an elective for outstanding students to gain flying experience in Adelaide, Australia during summer. Graduates can continue their study in local aviation-related degree programmes such as the Bachelor of Aviation (Honours) in Operations and Management by CCCU/UOWCHK, or pursue the Bachelor of Aviation (Pilot) programme offered by the University of South Australia in Adelaide for another 1.5 years. Holders of the certificate awarded upon completion of the Advanced Aviation Education Programme (AAEP) or BTEC Level 2 Certificate in Aviation Studies are also eligible to apply for credit transfer in the AScAvPS.

The General Entrance Requirement of the programme is Level 2 or above in five HKDSE subjects including Chinese Language and English Language, or with other equivalent qualifications.
