### Background:

Since 2007, the New Zealand Cadet Forces have invited Hong Kong Air Cadets Corps (the Corps) to join the Junior Outdoor Leadership Course. In the light of the success of the past 4 years, Honorary Squadron Leader Daniel K. Chan decided to establish a scholarship for JOLC to attract more outstanding cadets and make the trip attainable for the cadets who need financial assistance.

Operation Unicorn is an adventure training program organised by the Adventure Activities Squadron (AAS) of the Corps which provides training for, makes the selection of and facilitates the scholarship to the cadets joining the NZCF JOLC.

### Aims

- to select suitable candidates and provide training for them in preparing for the NZCF JOLC;
- to sharpen the leadership and interpersonal communications skills of candidates;
- to enhance candidates' physical fitness and perseverance;
- to give candidates insight into and raise their interest in outdoor adventure activities;
- to raise candidates' awareness in safety when conducting outdoor activities; and
- to promote environmental care.

### Qualification Offered

Trainee with at least 80% attendance and passes the assessments of all subjects will be offered a course completion certificate. According to the subjects that they pass, trainees will also be offered the following certificates or qualifications:

1. Hong Kong Mountaineering Union Level 1 Mountain Craft Training;
2. Hong Kong Mountaineering Union Level 2 Mountain Craft Training;
3. AYP Bronze or Silver Badge; and
4. HKACC Expedition
