

HONG KONG AIR CADET CORPS

Flag Day 2010 Incentive Scheme

1. Members of the Flag Day Project Committee

In respect of the level of achievement, Committee Members are eligible for possible awards under the Hong Kong Cadet Forces Honours Scheme or the Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps Commendation Scheme, subject in each case to nomination by the Commanding Officer, or the Chairman of the HKACC Flag 2010 Project Committee.

2. Gold Flag Scheme

In respect of the level of financial contributions, awards will be made to both members and non-members in accordance with the following qualifying criteria, subject to the restrictions set out in the *Prevention of Bribery Ordinance*:

Contributions of \$2,500 or above – Bronze Certificate of Special Merit

Contributions of \$5,000 or above – Silver Certificate of Special Merit

Contributions of \$10,000 or above – Gold Certificate of Special Merit

Contributions of \$25,000 or above – HKACC Bronze Medal of Special Merit

Contributions of \$50,000 or above – HKACC Silver Medal of Special Merit

Contributions of \$100,000 or above – HKACC Gold Medal of Special Merit

3. Revenue Sharing Scheme for field units

10% of the gross revenue of the Flag Day 2010 will be allocated to the Ops Gp and C Sqn /CT Sqn for sharing. The manner in which revenue will be shared is to be agreed between Ops Gp units and C Sqn /CT Sqn.

4. Incentive Scheme for External Organizations (other than uniformed groups) and Uniform Groups for turning out flag sellers

External Organizations (other than uniformed groups) or Uniform Groups must turn out at least 100 flag sellers to be eligible for consideration under the scheme.

4.1 External Organizations (other than uniformed groups)

Helicopter tours will be provided to the 1st three Schools with the largest number of flag sellers:-

- (1) winner: 32 persons (2 teachers + 30 students)
- (2) 1st runner-up: 16 persons (2 teachers + 14 students)
- (3) 2nd runner-up: 8 persons (1 teacher + 7 students)

4.2 Uniformed Groups

Helicopter tours will be provided to the 1st three Uniformed Groups with the largest number of flag sellers:-

- (1) winner: 32 persons (2 adult members + 30 cadet members)
- (2) 1st runner-up: 16 persons (2 adult members + 14 cadet members)
- (3) 2nd runner-up: 8 persons (1 adult member + 7 cadet members)

5. Incentive Scheme for HKACC squadrons/ flights for turning out flag sellers

HKACC squadrons/independent flights must turn out at least 100 flag sellers to be eligible for consideration under the scheme.

Helicopter tours will be awarded to the 1st three squadron/independent flights with the largest number of flag sellers:-

- (1) winner: 32 persons (2 senior members + 30 cadet members)
- (2) 1st runner-up: 16 persons (2 adult member + 14 cadet members)
- (3) 2nd runner-up: 8 persons (1 adult member + 7 cadet members)
