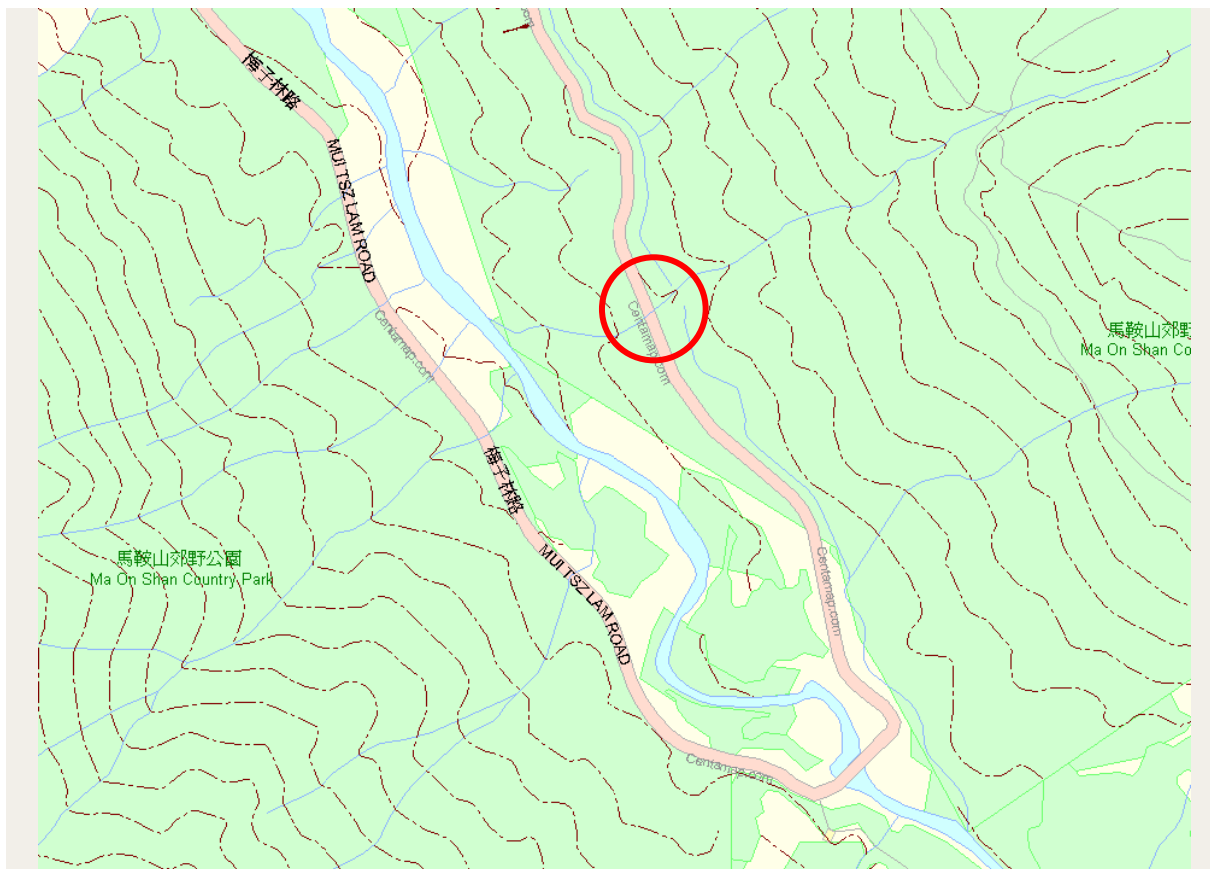
Remarks of Typhoon / Rainstorm Procedures

- When Typhoon Signal No.3 or above, Red or Black Rainstorm Signal is hoisted two hours prior to an outdoor activity, that activity must be cancelled and rescheduled.
- When Typhoon Signal No.3 or above, Red or Black Rainstorm Signal is hoisted, all outdoor activities must cease and all members must return home or take shelter in a safe place.
- When Typhoon Signal No.8 or above, Black Rainstorm Signal is hoisted, all indoor activities must cease and members must return home or take shelter in a safe place.
