

Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps
Assistance Scheme for Student Members 2026-2028
(1 April 2026– 31 March 2028)

Terms of Reference

1. Purpose

The *Assistance Scheme for Student Members* is funded by the Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps (HKACC) to provide uniform and activities subsidy to Students Members.

2. Eligibility

- (a) Hong Kong residents; and
- (b) Students from Primary 6 to Secondary 6; and
- (c) Cadet Members with financial difficulties who are receiving textbook grant / fee remission provided by the Student Financial Assistance Agency; or
- (d) Cadet Members from families receiving the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA); or
- (e) Other special circumstances recommended by OC unit.

3. Application Procedures

- (a) The form should be completed in black or blue ink or ball pen.
- (b) Completed form with supporting documents should be sent to HKACC Headquarters.

4. Use of Information

- (a) Information provided in the application form will be used for the following purposes:
 - (i) Activities relating to the processing and evaluation of the application; and
 - (ii) Activities relating to recovery of overpayments in future, if any.
- (b) The Application Form will be destroyed two years after the end of the scheme.

5. Vetting of Applications

Vetting of applications is conducted by a Working Group comprising Chief Staff Officer and Administrative Manager. Input of relevant major unit/unit commanders will be invited. Approval of applications to be made by the Commanding Officer based on recommendations by the Working Group. The approval of subsidy will be subjected to HKACC's discretion based on the number of applicants and financial status.

6. Notification of Application Results

HKACC Headquarters will inform the OC Unit of the application results by email.
