飛行夢計劃 – Visit to the Civil Aviation Flight University of China



Visit to the Civil Aviation Flight University of China in April 2025

Located in Sichuan Province, the [Civil Aviation Flight University of China](#) (CAFUC, 中國民用航空飛行學院) is the exclusive full-time regular institute of higher education for civil aviation pilots and other civil aviation professionals in the Mainland. CAFUC has state-of-the-art facilities and equipment for aviation training, including five well-equipped flight training airports, 378 flight training aircraft of 16 different types, as well as 59 flight simulators and exercise consoles. Besides flying training, CAFUC offers 43 undergraduate programmes and 20 master's degree programmes in various aviation expertise.

2. With the successful experience in April 2025 ([link](#) to CAFUC official reporting), CAFUC and the Corps will again jointly organize the captioned programme, with the support of the Government Flying Service. The details are as follows.

Venues	CAFUC Guanghan Flight College, Sichuan Province (四川省德陽市廣漢市 中國民用航空飛行學院廣漢分院) and other parts of the Sichuan Province
Eligibility	<u>Basic Requirements</u> Members of all ranks aged 15 – 25 (as at 1 April 2026) who: • Demonstrate excellent command in Putonghua and English; • Possess strong interest in aviation and pursuing a career in the aviation industry; • Possess a valid travel document to visit the Mainland; and • Be able to attend the activities, including a selection exercise and a pre-trip training, with full attendance. <u>Preferable Background</u> Members who have successfully completed Corps' Aviation Education programmes, e.g. GAINS, AAEP, AAEP(H), Glider Introductory Course and Operation Kingbird, or attained relevant aviation qualifications, will be favourably considered. That said, members who do not have such background but meet the basic requirements may still apply.

Remarks	1. Participants will be continually assessed and may face disqualification if performance is unsatisfactory. 2. Participants are required to compile a post-trip report and deliver presentations about the programme. Details of this requirement will be communicated to the participants.
