We are pleased to invite applications for the captioned Day Camp scheduled for 26.4.2025 at Stage 1, 3.5.2025 or 10.5.2025 at Stage 2.

2. The Day Camp is hosted by the University of Hong Kong with the Corps. This unique event is designed to offer participants an unforgettable opportunity to explore the world of remote-control aviation and enhance their technical skills in a fun and interactive way. During the Day Camp, participants will have the chance to:

- learn how to design and construct model airplanes;
- understand how engineers solve problems;
- foster teamwork; and
- promote unmanned aircraft system flying activities and safety.

<b>Venue</b>	Stage 1: (Indoor flying): Event Hall of Innovation Wing, Hui Oi Chow Science Building, the University of Hong Kong (HKU)  Stage 2: (Outdoor flying) Hong Kong Model Engineering Club at Yuen Long
<b>Language</b>	Cantonese
<b>Capacity:</b>	30
<b>Eligibility:</b>	Cadet members aged 13 or above, and adult members
<b>Price:</b>	Free of Charge (participants should prepare for their own lunch)

<b>Dressing</b>	Corps Polo Shirt / Squadron Tee-shirt / HKACC T-shirt with long trousers
<b>Remarks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Participants will have the opportunity to engage in model airplane building, flight training, and competitions at Stage 1.</li> <li>- Qualified students will progress to Stage 2, where they will receive a safety briefing and outdoor flight training under the guidance of experienced airplane instructors.</li> <li>- Lunch is not provided on 26.4.2025. Students may purchase their own lunch box at nearby restaurants or at HKU canteens.</li> </ul>

  - Cadet members who are below 18 years old must submit the Parent or Guardians Approval Form along with their application.
  - Adult Officers or NCOs are highly recommended to join the event as Team Leaders or Observers to collaborate with and support the team members.
  - Units with only one application are still encouraged to hand in their applications. The individual cadets will be regrouped to facilitate teamwork and learning motivation.
