REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD
OF THE FLIGHT SIMULATOR AVIATOR BADGE

1. *Eligibility*

The Flight Simulator Aviator Badge shall be authorised for wear by Senior and Cadet Members who have passed the prescribed qualification test and satisfied the annual recency simulator hour requirement of the Flight Simulator Aviator Scheme

2. *Description*

The Flight Simulator Aviator (FSA) Badge is a metal wing badge with a 5 cm wing span in gold colour. The centre of the badge features a globe symbolising the World Wide Web, with a letter “S” denoting synthetic and simulated flying. Surrounding the “S” are four lightning bolts, symbolising the nature of digitalised flight experiences. The Badge shall be worn on the right pocket flap of the No 1 Service Dress, No 2A (Long Sleeved) Routine Working / No 2B (Short Sleeved) Routine Working Dress, or a relative position on the female member’s No 1 Service Dress.

When worn with other badges on the right pocket flap, the badge of the higher order of precedence shall be positioned closer to the centre of the body of there wearer. Only two badges may be worn on the pocket flap at any time. The Flight Simulator Aviator Badge and UAS Aviator Badge shall not be worn simultaneously. Members awarded with both badges may choose which to wear. The order of precedence is as follows:

Flight Simulator Aviator Badge
UAS Aviator Badge
Honour Guard Badge
Marksman Badge

The senior members’ Flight Simulator Aviator Badge may be worn optionally on the No 8 Mess Dress on the lower right lapel following the order of precedence as listed below:

Commander’s Insignia
Flight Simulator Aviator Badge
UAS Aviator Badge
Honour Guard Badge
Marksman Badge
IACE Recognition Badge

3. *Recommending Authority*

Recommendations for the award of the Badge shall be submitted by the Aviation Education and Development Group to the Commanding Officer. The Badge shall be awarded on the authority of the Commanding Officer and a notification of such award shall be duly published.

Revocation of a member's right to wear the Flight Simulator Aviator Badge may be recommended by the Aviation Education and Development Group in case of a member failing to meet his/her annual recency requirements. Such revocation shall be made on the authority of the Commanding Officer and due notifications shall be made.
