No.2 Qualified Aviation Instructor Course - Course Information

The Qualified Aviation Instructor Course (QAIC) is a new initiative to prepare qualified members, especially cadets, to be competent trainers of designated aviation education subjects at Squadron, Wing and Corps levels. QAIC also serves to standardize aviation education training throughout the Corps. Upon successful completion of QAIC, members will be appointed as Qualified Aviation Instructors (QAIs).

2. The No.2 Qualified Aviation Instructor Course is tentatively scheduled from late November 2017 to early April 2018.

Privileges of QAIs

3. QAIs are recognized as competent trainers of the designated aviation education (AE) subjects including Airmanship, Aviation History, Aircraft Recognition, Principle of Flight, Government Flying Service and Civil Aviation in Hong Kong.

Remarks: Senior members who successfully completed OCTC / OTTC, or who are appointed through the AE specialist stream, regardless of being QAIs or not, are deemed to be capable of delivery of the aforementioned AE subjects at current.

- 4. Cadet QAIs are eligible to wear a light blue lanyard on their uniforms.
- 5. Cadets who are QAIs shall be deemed to have obtained pass results in four AE subjects at either the Senior Cadet or Staff Cadet classification. Full details are available in my previous memo dated 27 January 2017 with reference (2) in AE/CCR / HQ msg 034/17.

Renewal of QAIs

- 6. To ensure competency of serving QAIs, the term of qualification of QAI is subject to renewal every 3 years.
- 7. Successful renewal requires active service in QAI capacities at Squadron, Wing and Corps levels; and fulfillment of competency checks designated by AE Wing. Details will be announced by memo in due course.

Eligibility for QAIC

- 8. Senior members and cadets shall meet the following criteria:
 - a) Demonstrating a reasonably high proficiency in the use of English and Chinese;
 - b) Having a keen interest in AE subjects;
 - c) Committed to putting into good use the QAI qualification by delivering AE training to cadet members at Squadron, Wing and Corps levels;
 - d) Being recommended for enrolment into QAIC by their respective OC Units;
 - e) Achieved a classification of Leading Cadet or above (applicable to cadets only).
- 9. Priority will be accorded to eligible cadets.

Upcoming Course

- 10. Details of the No.2 QAIC will be available early November 2017. Subsequent memo will be released for announcement. Training days are tentatively scheduled on Wednesday evening and Saturday morning.
