REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD OF THE HONOUR GUARD BADGE

1. *Eligibility*

The Honour Guard Badge shall be authorized for wear by the following members:

- (a) Officers, Warrant Officers, Sergeant Instructors and Instructors who have passed the Honour Guard Officer Qualification Test; and
- (b) Cadet Members who have passed the Honour Guard Qualification Test.

2. *Description*

The Honour Guard Badge is a two-tone (gold and silver) metal badge featuring a pair of crossed ceremonial swords, surmounted by the Corps emblem, and surrounded by Chinese style laurel wreath. The Badge shall be worn on the right pocket flap on Nos 1, 2A and 2B uniforms, midway between the pocket flap button and the top seam of the pocket, or at a relative position on female members' No 1 uniform. If worn with another qualification badge on the right pocket flap, the two qualification badges are to be positioned on the two sides of and slightly above the pocket button, or at relative positions on female members' No 1 uniform, with the qualification badge of higher precedence closer to the centre of the chest. Only two qualification badges can be worn on the right pocket flap at the same time.

3. *Recommending Authority*

Recommendations for the award of the Honour Guard Badge shall be submitted by the Deputy Commanding Officer, Training, or the Deputy Commanding Officer, Operations, to the Commanding Officer. The Badge shall be awarded on the authority of the Commanding Officer and a notification of such award shall be duly published.
