**REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE AWARD
OF THE HONG KONG AIR CADET CORPS COMMANDER'S INSIGNIA**

1. *Eligibility*

The Hong Kong Air Cadet Corps Commander's Insignia shall be authorized for wear by Senior Members who are filling a command position at Corps, Group, Wing or Squadron level; or a position determined by the Commanding Officer as a command equivalent position. Deputy, acting, temporary or past commanders are not authorized to wear the Insignia.

2. *Description*

The Commander's Insignia is a gilt metal badge featuring a winged sword (signifying aviation and authority) superimposing a laurel wreath (the symbol of the office of command). The Insignia shall be worn by uniformed members on the right chest 1 cm above the right pocket on Nos 1, 2A and 2B uniforms, or 1 cm above the regulation name tag (if worn), or at a relative position on female members' No 1 uniform.

3. *Recommending Authority*

The award of the Commander's Insignia shall be authorized by the Commanding Officer, and a notification of such award shall be duly published.
