### THE VALIANT 2024 – ALLIANCE

#### Open for Application

#### (Extension of Application Deadline)

In the previous years, the Corps has sent out cadet representatives to the UK and the US to attend the Air Cadet Leadership Course (ACLC) and Hawk Mountain Ranger School (HMRS). Participants in ACLC will undergo a 7-day leadership training programme designed and organised by the Royal Air Force and Royal Air Force Air Cadets (RAFAC); while HMRS is an outdoor search and rescue programme offered by the Civil Air Patrol (CAP). In order to bring home the knowledge and skills learnt, members who have participated in these courses have established ‘The Valiant’, a camp which provides our cadets with outdoor experience and leadership training adopted from the UK and US outline.

This year, as the eleventh year of the foundation of ‘The Valiant’, members from **Hong Kong Adventure Corps (HKAC)** will jointly organise and participate in the camp. Not only to reunite and reintegrate members from both Corps, also to have the precious opportunity for the organising committee and campers to cooperation with and learn from each other. “The Valiant 2024 – Alliance” provides an opportunity to share and experience the know-how and training setting inspired by ACLC and HMRS with local characteristics will surely be different from normal training camps, and certainly be a “once-in-a-lifetime” experience in one’s cadet career.

Eligibility : Basic Cadet or above

Recognition : Annual Camp equivalence under Corps guidelines

Camp Fee : HKD 250

Remarks :

- (a) Campers should attend the full camp (including Selection Day) unless otherwise requested with supporting evidence, which should be enclosed during application submission if possible;
- (b) Fees paid are non-refundable or transferable;
- (c) Applicants who cannot attend the Selection Day will have their applications regarded with least priority; and
- (d) General Service Training Wing reserves the rights to make the final decision of the recognition that mentioned above.
